#### THE UK & EUROPEAN TOUR 1980

It was a record breaking tour in every sense. The Barclays played to approximately one quarter of a million fans! This is a staggering statistic and the biggest concert was in Frankfurt on 3 February when Barclay James Harvest played to over 14,000 fans. The Zurich concert on 16 March was packed to capacity with 12,000 fans. The tour encompassed 53 concerts in the following countries: Britain, Germany, Denmark, Spain, Portugal, France, Switzerland, Austria and Belgium. All 24 German concerts were sold out before the tour commenced and, in fact, the band broke German attendance records previously held by Pink Floyd in 1977 and Supertramp in 1979.

Unfortunately the anticipated American/Canadian tour never materialised.

After their concert in Zurich on 16 March Barclay James Harvest received gold records from Polydor Switzerland for "Gone To Earth", "XII" and "Eyes of the Universe"



On 13 February the Barclays broke another record. They were presented with the first platinum disc ever to be presented in Germany! Normally they give double gold albums. The platinum was for sales exceeding 500,000 for "Gone To Earth" and, at the same time, they were presented with a gold album for sales of 300,000 plus, for "Eyes of the Universe", and this in the first three months of its release.

So far, sales of Barclay James Harvest albums have amounted to more than TWO million units in Germany and, of these, one million have been sold in the past twelve months!

I think we are all agreed that the Barclays have proved themselves over and over again in Germany and are now one of the very top (if not the top) British bands over there.

The photo at the top of this page shows the boys receiving their gold albums in Switzerland and, if you turn over, the picture on page 3 shows them receiving their platinum album in Germany .....
