

BARCLAY JAMES HARVEST - The Crew.

Several of you have written to me with questions about the members of the road crew. So, without further ado, I will introduce them to you starting with SIMON REDSHAW - Production Manager.

Simon is 26 years old and has been with BARCLAY JAMES HARVEST since October 1978.

Simon left school at 17 and for several years worked with a P.A. and Lighting hire company organising equipment for tours for various artistes and events through Europe. Then followed a short period of free-lance tour management (everything from Gilbert O'Sullivan to Iggy Pop.)

Simon was introduced to BJH through Lindsay Brown (the group's Agent and Co-Manager) in 1978 and has worked on all their tours since. As production manager he is responsible for co-ordinating all the various aspects of a tour, i.e. sound, lights, crew, transport, rehearsals etc., which make the show happen.

When not on the road with B.J.H. Simon works from Handle Artists on the day-to-day running of BJH (ie organising crew, equipment, etc for albums and other projects). Recently, Simon has started a hire company for B.J.H. equipment, supplying to a wide range of artistes i.e. The Police, Supertramp, Kids from Fame, Kid Creole, Miguel Rios, etc which keeps the boys equipment and crew busy when not on the road with BJH.

Quote "It's a great life, the only problem I've got is that my mother keeps asking me when I'm going to get a proper job!"

Thanks to Simon for filling us in. Another member of the crew will be featured next time.

Also next time I will be putting your questions to IAN "BUCKO" BUXTON who is responsible for the boys' special effts. So please let me have any questions you may have about this subject before the end of November. Should be interesting.
